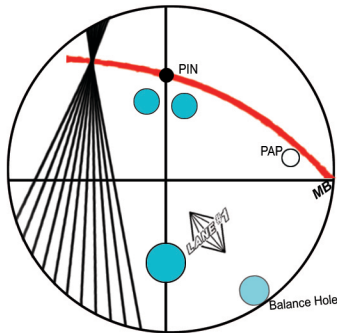

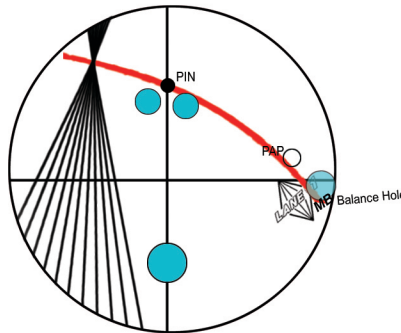
## Pro CG and 5"+ Long Pin Drilling Instructions

*Track Flare Bowtie is measured from the MB through the pin..!!*



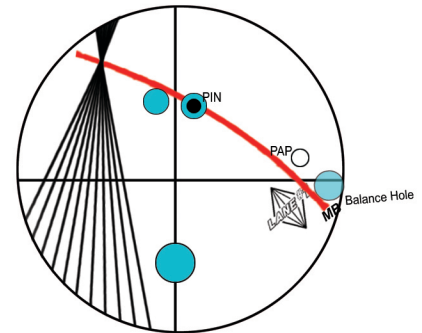
*Place pin above the fingers, with the MB on, or just below the midline. Balance hole will be in the thumb quadrant.*

*Track Flare Bowtie is measured from the MB through the pin..!!*



*Long Pins will have a similar layout as the Pro CG, but the balance hole will go near the midline and/or past 6 3/4" to add top weight.*

*Track Flare Bowtie is measured from the MB through the pin..!!*



*Higher tracks, place the pin inside the ring finger area, for more hook. Keep the MB no more than 1" below the midline.*

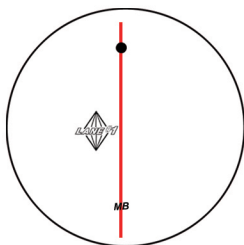
### Hints

*For balls with low starting top, place balance hole, on a line from the Center of Grip, extending out 10" to add top weight, moving the ending CG to your desired location.*

*Place balance hole wherever necessary to end with the desired ending static weights and/or desired ending center of gravity location.*

*Balls with higher top weight, place hole no more than 6 3/4" from the center of your grip.*

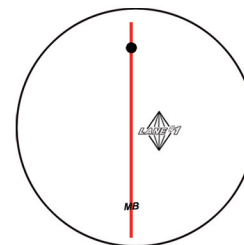
**CG Left** (normally for righties)



*Balls with CG Left or CG right will use different balance hole locations to get to the desired ending static weights.*

*Balance holes less than 29/32" can be placed in the center of flare rings with no thumping.*

**CG Right** (normally for lefties)
